**Leviticus 19:3** – Ye shall fear every man his mother, and his father, and keep my sabbaths: I am the LORD your God.

**Ephesians 6:1** – Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right.

**Ephesians 6:2** – Honor your father and mother which is the first commandment with a promise.

**Proverbs 6:20** – My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother:

**Proverbs 10:1** – A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother.

**Proverbs 19:26** – He that wasteth his father, and chaseth away his mother, is a son that causeth shame, and bringeth reproach.

**Proverbs 20:20** – Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness.

**Proverbs 23:22** – Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old.

**Mark 7:10-12** – For Moses said, Honour thy father and thy mother; and, Whoso curseth father or mother, let him die the death:

**Proverbs 22:6** – Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it.

**Proverbs 23:13-14** – Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die.

**Proverbs 23:22** – Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old.

**Proverbs 29:15** – The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself bringeth his mother to shame.

## What did Jesus say about His Mother?

---

Maybe the thought has crossed your mind on the question — what did Jesus say about His Mother? It is revealed in scripture several times how much Jesus loved his mother. For example, at the wedding of Cana, Jesus turned the water into wine just because his Mother asked him to. It wasn't his time yet to perform miracles, yet, he honored her request.

Another example of Jesus' love for his mother is when Jesus was dying on the cross. As he was in pain and agony, he was still taking care of his mother. He cried to his beloved disciple, John, son of Zebedee, to take care of his mother when he was gone.

Here are perfect examples of wonderful stories of KJV Bible Verses about Mothers with Jesus:

**John 19:25-27** – Now there stood by the cross of Jesus his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene. 26 When Jesus therefore saw his mother, and the disciple standing by, whom he loved, he saith unto his mother, *Woman, behold thy son!* 27 Then saith he to the disciple, *Behold thy mother!* And from that hour that disciple took her unto his own home.

**John 2:1-11** And the third day there was a marriage in Cana of Galilee; and the mother of Jesus was there: 2 And both Jesus was called, and his disciples, to the marriage. 3 And when they wanted wine, the mother of Jesus saith unto him, They have no wine. 4 Jesus saith unto her, *Woman, what have I to do with thee? mine hour is not yet come.* 5 His mother saith unto the servants, *Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it.* 6 And there were set there six waterpots of stone, after the manner of the purifying of the Jews, containing two or three firkins apiece. 7 Jesus saith unto them, *Fill the waterpots with water. And they filled them up to the brim.* 8 And he saith unto them, *Draw out now, and bear unto the governor of the feast. And they bare it.* 9 When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: (but the servants which drew the water knew;) the governor of the feast called the bridegroom, 10 And saith unto him, *Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: but thou hast kept the good wine until now.* 11 This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.
