Lastly, I chose a variety of topics that reach the heart of any man, woman, or child.

Colossians 3:2 - Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

Teaching Tip: Your material possessions are not important, your spiritual development and growth are key to a happy and content life.

Psalms 74:17 - Thou hast set all the borders of the earth: thou hast made summer and winter.

Teaching Tip: God is creator over everything we see, feel, taste, and smell. He has made the earth and the four seasons, including the summer season.

James 1:17 - Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Teaching Tip: Anything good comes from God, He never changes, but is our source of light and will never be our source for a shadow, turning from God.

Ephesians 4:32 - Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Teaching Tip: Always be kind to each other, whether it's your spouse, child, or stranger. If someone has offended you, forgive them as Christ has forgiven you.

Jeremiah 29:11 - "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

Teaching Tip: God has plans FOR YOU, you are not a mistake. He wants you to prosper in all you do, plus, you have hope and a bright future under His direction.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 - In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

Teaching Tip: Whatever situation you are in, give thanks to God. Your circumstances are exactly where you should be even if you don't understand. It may have a purpose to teach, admonish, but it's always designed to draw you closer to Him.

1 Corinthians 15:33 - Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

Teaching Tip: Stay away from those or speak evil things, keep your good manners. If you continue to listen to evil doers, you will easily be deceived and become corrupt like them.

Proverbs 1:7 - The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction.

Teaching Tip: The only thing to fear is the Lord, once you fear Him, that's when life changes. Your game changing ways will allow you to receive instruction, understand, and gain wisdom.

Romans 1:16 - For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek.

Teaching Tip: Do not be ashamed of the gospel of Christ as it's powerful and for everyone that believes.

Proverbs 6:6-8 - Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise. 7 Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, 8 Provideth her meat in the summer, [and] gathereth her food in the harvest.

Key Point: Work hard no matter what you are doing, and do what you are supposed to do whether it's cleaning the toilet, picking up toys, teaching your kids, or running a household.

Teaching Tip: Be kind to each other whether it's a sibling, friend, or someone who wants to harm you with their words. Forgive those who need forgiven as Christ has forgiven us many times over.

Psalm 119:11 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

Teaching Tip: Memorizing Bible Verses is biblical! It keeps you from sinning.

Psalm 37:4 Delight thyself also in the Lord: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

Teaching Tip: Be delightful in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart.

Bible Verse Memorization Tips

One key Bible Verse for kids Ephesians 4:32 has been repeated again due to its high relevancy with kids. While their temptations are different on a smaller scale than adults, there are many similarities as well. Children have a tendency to be cruel to siblings and others whether it's coveting toys, jealousy of attention, or forgiving someone who was mean to them. Teach them this easy Bible Verse at a young age and constantly repeat it throughout the day when appropriate. My kids didn't have to memorize this one as it was repeated many times during their younger years.
